CLEAN-UP, CARE, AND STORAGE

WARNING

Keep hands out of feather chute. **DO NOT** attempt to clear feathers or other debris from feather chute when the appliance is plugged in. Turn off, unplug, and allow the plucker to come to a complete stop before cleaning or removing foreign matter.

- 1. Turn off and unplug the machine before clean up or disassembly.
- 2. Keep hands out of feather chute. **DO NOT** attempt to remove bird, feathers or debris from the plucker when plugged in.
- 3. Disassemble tub and feather plate from base and wash thoroughly in hot soapy water.
- 4. You must remove all foreign material from all appliance parts.
- 5. **DO NOT** use bleach or chlorine-based chemicals to clean. Discoloration of plastic parts can occur.
- 6. Wipe down all non-stainless steel parts with a food-grade silicone spray. Alternatively, if silicone spray is not available, vegetable oil can be used. Silicone spray is the suggested lubricant to use. Unlike vegetable oil, silicone spray will not build up or become gummy. It lubricates and repels water and leaves a protective coating to keep rust from forming.
- 7. **DO NOT** immerse or spray directly at the motor or motor housing. Damage to motor can occur.
- 8. It is best to keep the unit stored indoors or covered, not exposed to weather.
- 9. Allow appliance to dry completely prior to storage.

- Keep hands and fingers away from moving parts. Never reach into the appliance until it has come to a complete stop. Keep hands clear of feather chute. DO NOT attempt to clear feathers or other debris from feather chute. Turn off and unplug unit before cleaning or removing poultry or any foreign matter from the plucker.
- DO NOT spray water directly at the motor. Incidental water contact is okay.
- Always turn off and unplug plucker before cleaning, performing maintenance, assembly, or disassembly. Unplug when not in use.
- DO NOT allow children to operate this machine. Adults should not operate without proper instruction and without
 first reading the product manual. Close supervision should be used when children are near.
- NEVER move the unit when it is running.


- For your safety, this appliance is equipped with a 3-pronged, grounding plug and must be plugged into a properly
 grounded outlet. Do not cut off the third (grounding) prong. Do not use an adapter.
- The appliance must be connected to an 120V AC electric supply only.
- To turn it on, first plug appliance into electrical outlet and then turn the appliance on. Turn appliance off and remove plug from outlet when not in use.
- Keep electrical cords suspended above surfaces that collect water and out of walkways to avoid tripping hazard.
- This device uses both electricity and water to pluck birds efficiently & effectively.
- This appliance is equipped with a GFCI (ground-fault circuit interrupter) that protects the operator. NEVER tamper with, disable, or remove the GFCI.
- Using this appliance with an extension cord may cause a decrease in electrical current, causing the motor to be over worked and possibly catch fire. Use of proper gauge wire extension cord is required.
- Never unplug by pulling on the power cord, always pull directly on the plug itself.
- DO NOT let cord hang over edge of table or counter, contact sharp edges, touch hot surfaces or sit in pooled water.
- To protect against the risk of electrical shock, never immerse the motor in water or expose it to direct water spray.

PARTS USAGE




NOTE: Maximum combined weight of poultry/birds to be plucked at one time is 16 lbs. Individual birds weighing more than 8 lbs. should not be put in the plucker.

- 1. Make sure all safety features are operational, including the GFCI, proximity and on/off switches. Test them prior to plucking by turning them off and on again.
- 2. Check that all bolts and nuts are tightly fastened. (Check hardware prior to each use. Vibration of the machine may cause them to loosen.)
- B. Keep electrical connections out of areas where water can pool.
- Plug in the plucker. **NOTE:** Each time it is plugged in, you must press the reset button on the GFCI. **The machine will not start without this step.**
- **Prepare bird for plucking:** Put the bird into scalding water (140-150 F) for approximately 45 seconds. Move the bird about to facilitate hot water getting past the oil on the feathers to the skin.
- 6. Attach water on/off valve and water hose to hose connector.
- 7. Adding a small amount of dish soap to the scalding water will allow hot water to penetrate to the skin. Birds have oil on their feathers and breaking down the oil will allow the hot water to reach the skin. If plucking waterfowl we suggest adding extra soap in the scalding water to assist in the breakdown of the oils. Check bird for a good scald prior to plucking. Tug on largest tail feathers by hand, once they pull out easily you can transfer the bird to the plucker. Waterfowl test feathers should be pulled from the breast easily prior to transferring to the plucker.
- 8. Turn on the plucker and allow the turn table to get to speed prior to adding the birds.
- 9. Turn on the water and allow the turntable to get up to speed prior to adding the birds. This ensures feathers are continually flushed. (**Note**: Plucking two birds at the same time is more efficient than plucking one at a time.)
- 10. Immediately after scalding, place birds into spinning tub. A properly scalded bird should be completely plucked in approximately 15-20 seconds.
- 11. Turn off the plucker and allow it to come to a complete stop before removing birds.
- 12. Unplug the plucker before attempting to remove feathers or debris from plucker. Unplug when not in use.



GETTING STARTED (ASSEMBLY)

4. The two part proximity switch is installed on the tub and base of the plucker. Both parts must be properly aligned for the plucker to function. Install the tub so that the 2 yellow arrows are aligned. Reinstall buckles and carabiners.



GETTING STARTED (PRE-USAGE)

- 1. Check that the buckle clamps have secured the tub to the base and that the proximity switch is aligned.
- Plug in power cord taking time to arrange power cord out of walkway and in location where water will not pool. Keep children away from power cord.
- 3. Plug into grounded outlet or proper gauge extension cord. Use power specifications on page 4 to determine proper gauge extension cord.
- 4. Attach water hose to water shut off valve. (Water hose not included.)
- 5. We suggest using a bucket under the feather chute to catch feathers and to help deflect feather and water away from motor. (You may want to drill holes in the base of the bucket to allow water to flow out.)

Note: GFCI is ready when green light is illuminated.

TIPS AND TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Solution
Unit stops suddenly while working	Press the GFCI button, and power switch on the motor.
	Weight of birds is too much. Birds must weigh under 8lbs. each. Max 2 birds at a time. Always allow turntable to get to speed prior to adding birds.
	Proximity switch has become misaligned. Turn off and unplug unit, realign arrows and resume use.
Unit will not start	Press the reset button on GFCI every time when you plug in the unit.

For longevity of the motor, it is suggested to put a 5-gallon bucket under the feather chute to catch feathers and water, and to keep both from getting on the motor shroud. Holes can be drilled in the bucket for water drainage.


Legs of the plucker: each leg is unique and they are not interchangeable. The legs with the axle brackets attached should be assembled so that the axle brackets and wheels are parallel with each other.

GETTING STARTED (ASSEMBLY)

1. Remove unit from the box. Unit is heavy. Use proper lifting techniques and a partner for assistance. Remove all parts from inside of Tub assembly, including the legs, wheels, feather chute, turntable, and bag of bolts and nuts (there are extra bolts and nuts included, and so you will not use all of them.)


Unwrap legs, handle and wheels. (Do not use sharp object to cut tape. Use caution so not to scar paint on legs). For assembly you will need a Phillips screwdriver, a 1/2" ratchet, and an adjustable wrench or 2 adjustable wrenches. Unbuckle all buckles on the base of the tub to release the base of the product. Extra metal pieces can be discarded after assembly is complete, they are for transit purposes only. Reuse carabiners on buckles.

Rubber fingers are installed on the tub assembly and the turntable. (In the future should the unit stop defeathering as efficiently and effectively as it did in the beginning of use, these fingers are replaceable and available at RootsandHarvest.com). Install the wheels using cotter pins to attach them to the legs. Using long bolts and locking nuts assemble legs and handle to base matching lettered parts to letters on the base. Install feather chute so that the opening is facing away from the motor.



GETTING STARTED (ASSEMBLY)

2.Once the handle, legs, wheels, and chute are assembled flip base over. Remove wax paper with zip tie from the drive, being very careful not to displace the keyway. The keyway is easily removable and replaceable and must be in place for the turntable to function properly. Line up the center hole in the base plate to the drive with keyway and slide turntable over drive and keyway. Place 2 washers and the domed washer (concave side down) over the drive and secure with short bolt.



3. Install tub assembly. Base plate and tub assembly come with the proximity switch preinstalled. It is imperative that these two pieces are properly aligned for the product to function. There are two yellow arrows to help with alignment. Once they are aligned, use the buckles to attach the tub assembly to the base plate and reinstall carabiners.

Once the majority of the plucker is assembled you can use the zip ties to fasten the power cord and install the on/off switch to the handle. Assemble the water hose on/off valve to the water hose attachment at the top of the tub. This is where the water hose will be attached when ready for use.
